




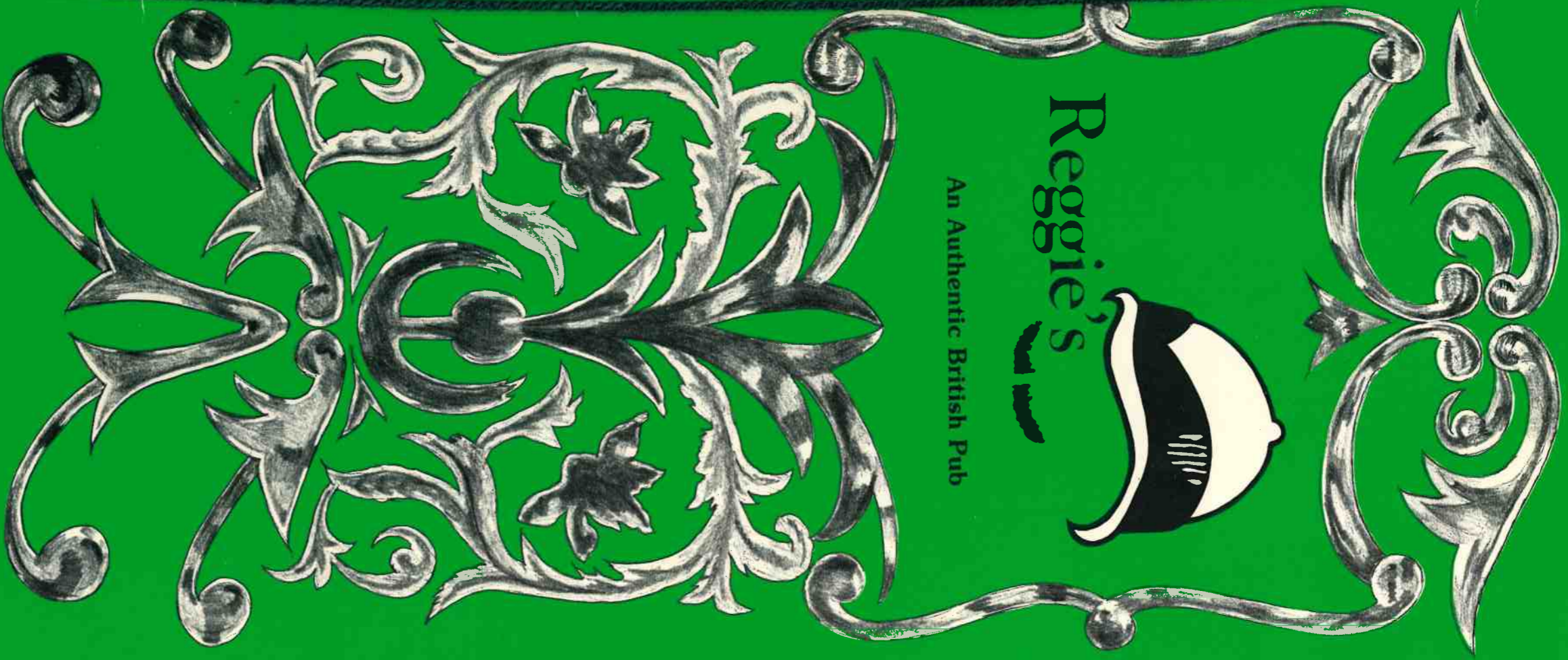
Reggie Mitchell, the founder of "Reggie's," has led an interesting and colourful life. He served in the Royal Marines and the Punjab Frontier Force (Piffers) of the Indian Army. The colours of this famous regimental grouping are to be seen in the decor of "Reggie's," dark green, red and gold. After serving in India, Burma & Thailand he was demobilized at the University of Georgia. On completing his studies he worked his way around North America as a free lance writer, actor, lumberjack, ranch hand, construction worker and he even sold encyclopedias to the Eskimos. Reggie met his wife Patsy at a film studio in Brighton, England, his home town, upon his return from Alaska. Later he worked in advertising and publicity and became an authority on mens fashions both in Atlanta and in London where he was for several years Director of the British Menswear Guild. In 1973, whilst serving as a consultant for Omni International he was persuaded to try his hand at opening a British Pub in Atlanta and "Reggie's" is the result. Often he and his family are on hand to greet old and new friends. Occasionally, Reggie still recites Kipling's verse to appreciative Atlanta audiences and takes part in radio and television commercials; and he was very proud when "Reggie's" was written up recently in Time Magazine. The memorabilia on the walls are mostly personal moments and family pictures including one of Reggie's more famous ancestors, Lord Cornwallis. On the 4th of July "Reggie's" holds a "Grand Losers Party" to honour Cornwallis and General George Washington, and to mark their historic meeting at Yorktown.

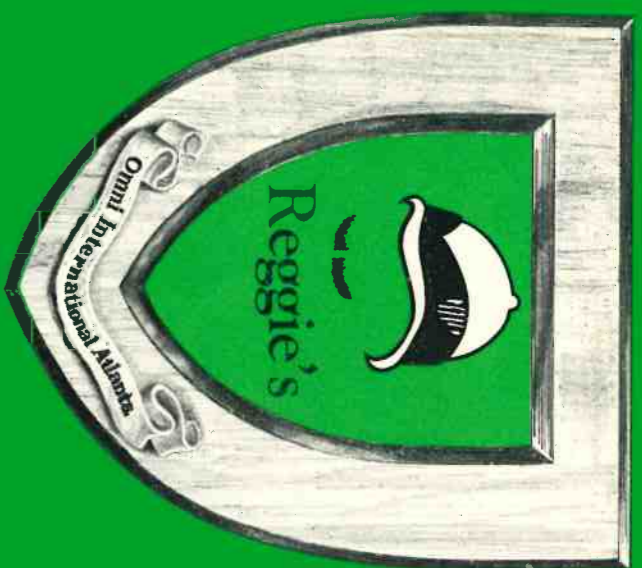

Many of...

The pictures on the walls of "Reggie's" reflect the atmosphere of the Victorian period.

They include lithographs and engravings from the illustrated London News depicting military events of the period.

Also there are photographs of Reggie's Grandfather and Great Uncle: The Honourable Arthur Cornwallis Ponsonby and his older brother Edward the 7th Earl of Bessborough.

Among other illustrations is an original rendering of Whitehall, London, used for the poster inaugurating the Delta Airlines Atlanta—London route.

At the end of the Bar is a photograph of Reggie's father, Tommy Mitchell who acted as pacemaker for Charlie Hart in 1914 on a 156 mile British marathon run and who, in 1919, beat Charlie Hart for the 50 mile world championship.

Behind the Bar is a photograph of Reggie with two of his soldiers taken in Rangoon, Burma, while he was serving in the Indian Army.

There are also pictures depicting the Fall of an ancestor, Sir William Ponsonby, who commanded the famous Union Brigade at Waterloo; a great uncle Lord Raglan; and photographs of Reggie's son Gerald with the 11th Hussars, and younger son, Ian saluting the recreated 2nd. Georgia Battalion, Continental Line.

An original watercolor of Sir Winston Churchill which was painted for the third volume of his official biography by Martin Gilbert, is also among the group.
